(1) "Authorized user" means, with respect to a protected computer, (i) a director, officer or employee of the owner, operator or lessee of such computer or the owner of information stored in the protected computer (ii) such owner's third-party agents, contractors, consultants and any of their respective employees; provided that any such person has been granted access to such protected computer by its owner, operator or lessee or the owner of information stored in such protected computer in the form of a technological access barrier. An employer provides explicit permission to an employee by providing the employee with a technological access barrier within the scope of the

employee's employment. Such permission, however, shall be deemed terminated upon cessation of the employee's employment.

Remove lines 76-83 and insert:

(8) "Without authorization" means access to a protected computer by any one of the following: (i) a person who is not an authorized user, (ii) a person who has stolen a technological access barrier of an authorized user or (iii) a person circumventing a technological access barrier on a protected computer without the express or implied permission of the owner, operator, or lessee of the computer or the express or implied permission of the owner of information stored in the protected computer; provided that for purposes of subsection (iii) in this definition, the term does not include circumventing a technological measure that does not effectively control access to the protected computer or the information stored in the protected computer.
