30 Pearl Harbor Survivors Association or proof of active military
31 duty in Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941, proof of being a
32 Purple Heart medal recipient, proof of active or retired
33 membership in any branch of the United States Armed Forces
34 Reserve, ~~or~~ proof of membership in the Combat Infantrymen's
35 Association, Inc., ~~or other~~ proof of being a recipient of the
36 Combat Infantry Badge, Combat Medical Badge, ~~or~~ Combat Action
37 Badge, Combat Action Ribbon, Air Force Combat Action Medal, or
38 Distinguished Flying Cross, and upon payment of the license tax
39 for the vehicle as provided in s. 320.08, shall be issued a
40 license plate as provided by s. 320.06, ~~upon~~ which, in lieu of
41 the serial numbers prescribed by s. 320.06, is ~~shall be~~ stamped

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42 with the words "Veteran," "World War II Veteran," "Woman
43 Veteran," "Navy Combat Veteran," "Marine Corps Combat Veteran,"
44 "Air Force Combat Veteran," "Navy Submariners," "National
45 Guard," "Pearl Harbor Survivor," "Combat-wounded veteran," "U.S.
46 Reserve," "Combat Infantry Badge," "Combat Medical Badge," or
47 "Combat Action Badge," "Combat Action Ribbon," "Air Force Combat
48 Action Medal," or "Distinguished Flying Cross," as appropriate,
49 and a likeness of the related ~~campaign~~ medal, ribbon, or badge,
50 followed by the serial number of the license plate.
51 Additionally, the Purple Heart plate may have the words "Purple
52 Heart" stamped on the plate and the likeness of the Purple Heart
53 medal appearing on the plate.

56 (c) Any revenue generated from the sale of Woman Veteran
57 License Plates shall be deposited in the Operations and
58 Maintenance Trust Fund administered by the Department of
59 Veteran's Affairs pursuant to s. 20.375(3) and are to be used
60 solely for the purpose of creating and implementing programs to
61 benefit women veterans. Notwithstanding any provisions of law to
62 the contrary, an applicant for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license
63 plate or a Purple Heart license plate who also qualifies for a
64 disabled veteran's license plate under s. 320.084 shall be
65 issued the appropriate special license plate without payment of
66 the license tax imposed by s. 320.08.

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67 (2) Each owner or lessee of an automobile or truck for
68 private use, a truck weighing not more than 7,999 pounds, or a
69 recreational vehicle as specified in s. 320.08(9)(c) or (d),
70 which is not used for hire or commercial use, who is a resident
71 of this ~~the~~ state and who is a former prisoner of war, or his or
72 her ~~their~~ unremarried surviving spouse, ~~shall,~~ upon application
73 ~~therefor~~ to the department, shall be issued a license plate as
