5 Remove lines 25-50 and insert:

6 (2) The Department of Transportation is required to
7 display a public awareness sign as described in (b) at all rest
8 areas, turnpike service plazas, weigh stations, welcome centers,
9 and public transit facilities in the state that are open to the
10 public.

11 (a) The department may not expend more than \$50,000 to
12 produce the signs required by this subsection.

13 (b) The public awareness sign must be at least 8.5 inches
14 by 11 inches in size, must be printed in at least a 16-point
15 type, and shall include, the following in English, Spanish, or
16 any other language deemed necessary by the department:
