11 (1) An agency or institution as defined in s. 1002.22(1)

13 (c) Enter into any agreement that does not expressly: 14 <u>1. Prohibit the sale or distribution of any student data</u> 15 <u>and access to any student data except as instructed by the</u> 16 <u>agency or institution to comply with local, state, or federal</u> 17 <u>reporting requirements.</u>

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18	2. Prohibit the mining of student data for commercial
19	purposes, including the targeting of advertising based upon such
20	data.
21	3. Require that all student data remain the property of the
22	agency or institution and that such data must be returned upon
23	request or be destroyed using a method designed to ensure
24	confidentiality and permanently deleted from any computer
