Section 13. Section 570.845, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

570.845 Agricultural hemp study.-

(1) The department shall conduct a study on the feasibility of cultivating agricultural hemp in this state. The Legislature intends to promote economic development and job growth through the cultivation, processing, distribution, manufacturing, and sale of hemp. Notwithstanding chapter 893, it is not a violation of state or local law to grow or cultivate hemp for the purposes of this study.

- Agricultural Sciences of the University of Florida may grow or cultivate agricultural hemp in no more than five locations, to be determined by the department, for the purpose of studying the growth, cultivation, and marketing of agricultural hemp. The institute shall submit quarterly reports to the department containing recommendations on the most effective ways to grow hemp in this state.
- (4) The department shall provide a report on the implementation of the study to the Governor and the Legislature by December 1, 2019. At a minimum, the report must include recommendations on the feasibility of legalizing the production of agricultural hemp in this state.
- (5) The department may adopt rules to administer this section.
 - (6) This section expires June 30, 2020.
