and insert:

<u>397.402 Single, consolidated license.-No later than January</u> <u>1, 2016, the department, in consultation with the Agency for</u> <u>Health Care Administration, shall modify licensure rules and</u> <u>procedures to create an option for a single, consolidated</u> <u>license for a provider that offers multiple types of mental</u> health and substance abuse services regulated under this chapter

12	must operate these services through a single corporate entity
13	and a unified management structure. Any provider serving both
14	adults and children must meet department standards for separate
