316.0275 Noncriminal traffic infractions leading to serious bodily injury or death; reclassification.-

(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, if an individual commits a noncriminal traffic infraction under this chapter which causes serious bodily injury or death to a person and within 5 years after that violation, commits another noncriminal traffic infraction under this chapter which causes serious bodily injury or death to a person, the second such violation shall be reclassified as a misdemeanor of the first
