Section 10. Body Camera Pilot Program. -- The Department of Corrections shall implement a pilot program in which correctional officers who work in the mental health units at Union Correctional Institution are equipped with body cameras. The pilot program shall expire on June 30, 2016. At the conclusion of the pilot program, the Department of Corrections shall submit a report by January 1, 2017, to the Executive Office of the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The report must compare the number of use of force incidents that occur in the mental health units at Union Correctional Institution while the pilot program was in effect with:
