2	A resolution recognizing May 2015 as "Lupus Awareness
3	Month" in Florida.
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5	WHEREAS, lupus is a cruel and mysterious chronic autoimmune
6	disease in which the immune system is unbalanced, causing
7	inflammation and tissue damage to virtually every organ system
8	in the body, and
9	WHEREAS, there are an estimated 1.5 million Americans who
10	have lupus, including an estimated 100,000 Floridians, and
11	WHEREAS, lupus can affect any part of the body, including
12	the skin, lungs, heart, kidneys, and brain, which can lead to
13	seizures, strokes, heart attacks, miscarriages, and organ
14	failure, and
15	WHEREAS, while lupus strikes mostly women of childbearing
16	age, African Americans are more likely than Caucasians to
17	develop lupus, and
18	WHEREAS, lupus can be particularly difficult to diagnose
19	because its symptoms are similar to those of many other
20	illnesses and often vary from person to person, and
21	WHEREAS, it takes, on average, six or more years before
22	people with lupus obtain a correct diagnosis, and
23	WHEREAS, only one new drug has been approved by the United
24	States Food and Drug Administration specifically for lupus in
25	more than 50 years, and current treatments for the disease can
26	have damaging side effects, NOW, THEREFORE,
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28	Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of
29	Florida:
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31	That May 2015 is recognized as "Lupus Awareness Month" in
32	Florida.
