House Resolution

A resolution designating April 14, 2015, as "Guardian ad Litem Day" in the State of Florida.

5 WHEREAS, founded in 1980, the Florida Guardian ad Litem 6 Program represents the best interests of abused and neglected 7 children in dependency court proceedings, and

8 WHEREAS, during the past 35 years, more than 30,000 9 dedicated and talented volunteers have served as guardians ad 10 litem in Florida, advocating for more than 200,000 of the 11 state's most vulnerable children, and

12 WHEREAS, studies have shown that children who have a 13 volunteer guardian ad litem receive more services and are half 14 as likely to return to foster care, and

15 WHEREAS, the Florida Guardian ad Litem Program has extended 16 its reach through public and private partnerships in communities 17 throughout the state, and

18 WHEREAS, the Florida Guardian ad Litem Program has worked 19 tirelessly to enhance the lives of children and give them every 20 opportunity to succeed, and

21 WHEREAS, Florida leads the nation in efforts to ensure that 22 every abused or neglected child has a dedicated guardian ad 23 litem, giving these children a voice in court, NOW, THEREFORE, 24
