A bill to be entitled

An act relating to daylight saving time; providing a short title; requiring that the State of Florida and its political subdivisions observe daylight saving time year-round; providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the State of Florida is known as the "Sunshine State," and

WHEREAS, as the "Sunshine State," Florida should be kept sunny year-round, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. (1) This section may be cited as the "Sunshine Protection Act."
- (2) Notwithstanding how time is advanced pursuant to 15 U.S.C. s. 260a, daylight saving time shall be the year-round standard time of the entire state and all of its political subdivisions.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2016.
