However, if the court 22 determines that the request to inspect or copy a public record 23 was made in bad faith or was frivolous, the court may not award any reasonable costs of enforcement, including reasonable 24 25 attorney fees, against the responsible agency. 26 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
