Determines that the vehicle is locked or there is 20 21 otherwise no reasonable method for the elderly person, disabled

2. Has a good faith belief that forcible entry into the vehicle is necessary because the elderly person, disabled adult, minor, or domestic animal is in imminent danger of suffering harm if not immediately removed from the vehicle and, based upon

adult, minor, or domestic animal to exit the vehicle.

- 4. Remains with the elderly person, disabled adult, minor, or domestic animal in a safe location, out of the elements but reasonably close to the vehicle, until a law enforcement officer, firefighter, or other first responder arrives.
- 5. Uses no more force to enter the vehicle and remove the elderly person, disabled adult, minor, or domestic animal from the vehicle than necessary under the circumstances.
- (b) As used in this subsection, the term "domestic animal" means a dog, cat, or other animal that is domesticated and kept as a household pet, but does not include livestock or other farm animals.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
