An act relating to law enforcement officer-involved shootings; requiring a local law enforcement agency to report a law enforcement officer-involved shooting to the state attorney and Attorney General; requiring the local law enforcement agency to report the shooting to the United States Department of Justice under certain circumstances; encouraging the United States

Department of Justice to conduct a full investigation; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Reporting law enforcement officer-involved shootings.—A local law enforcement agency must report a law enforcement officer-involved shooting to the state attorney and Attorney General. If the state attorney or the Attorney General does not begin an investigation within 60 days, the local law enforcement agency must report the law enforcement officer-involved shooting to the United States Department of Justice, and that department is encouraged to conduct a full investigation.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2016.
