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An act relating to educational instruction; creating s. 1003.481, F.S.; requiring the Commissioner of Education to develop an elective course for certain students which must be included in the Course Code Directory; requiring the elective course to include instruction in certain skills; authorizing the State Board of Education to adopt rules; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 1003.481, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

1003.481 Instruction in life skills.-

- (1) The Commissioner of Education, in consultation with the Articulation Coordinating Committee, shall develop an elective course for students in grades 9 through 12 that addresses skills and character development not included in rigorous academic courses.
- (2) The course must be included in the Course Code Directory and, at a minimum, include instruction on:
- (a) Developing leadership skills, interpersonal skills, organization skills, and research skills.
  - (b) Creating a resume.
- (c) Developing and practicing the skills necessary for employment interviews.
  - (d) Managing stress and expectations.
- (e) Developing personal skills that enable students to become resilient and self-motivated.
- (3) The State Board of Education may adopt rules to implement this section.
