Bill resulted in a 7-to-1 28 return on investment for our national economy and the fact that workers with college degrees earn more money, pay more taxes, 29 30 and rely less on government services, and 31 WHEREAS, student loan debt saddles the students who most 32 depend on the power of a college degree to level the economic
