At the end of existing proviso language, following Specific Appropriation 385, INSERT:

From the funds in Specific Appropriation 385, the recurring sum of \$500,000 from the General Revenue Fund is provided to the Transition House in Osceola County for substance abuse and mental health services for homeless veterans.
