A bill to be entitled

An act relating to compensation for representation; amending s. 27.5304, F.S.; revising compensation amounts for representation in a criminal proceeding; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Subsection (5) of section 27.5304, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
- 27.5304 Private court-appointed counsel; compensation; notice.-
- (5) The compensation for representation in a criminal proceeding shall not exceed the following:
- (a) For misdemeanors and juveniles represented at the trial level: \$1,000.
- (b) For noncapital, nonlife felonies represented at the trial level: $$15,000 \frac{$6,000}{}$.
- (c) For life felonies represented at the trial level: \$15,000 \$9,000.
- (d) For capital cases represented at the trial level: \$25,000. For purposes of this paragraph, a "capital case" is any offense for which the potential sentence is death and the state has not waived seeking the death penalty.
 - (e) For representation on appeal: \$9,000.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2016.
