each participating district as a salary supplement, a fund for

or both, as determined by the district. To be eligible for a
salary supplement under this subsection, a participating
principal must:

1. Be rated "highly effective" as determined by the
principal's performance evaluation under s. 1012.34;

2. Be transferred to a school that earned a grade of "F"
or three consecutive grades of "D" pursuant to s. 1008.34 and
provided additional authority and responsibilities pursuant to
s. 1012.28(8); and
