34 legal representative may purchase and possess cannabis for the
35 patient's medical use.

36 (b) Notwithstanding s. 381.986, s. 893.13, s. 893.135, s.
37 893.147, or any other provision of law, but subject to the
38 requirements of this section, an approved dispensing
39 organization licensed under s. 381.986 and its owners, managers,
40 and employees may manufacture, possess, sell, deliver,
41 distribute, dispense, and lawfully dispose of cannabis.

42 (c) An approved dispensing organization licensed under s.
43 381.986 and its owners, managers, and employees are not subject
44 to licensure or regulation under chapter 465 for manufacturing,
45 possessing, selling, delivering, distributing, dispensing, or
46 lawfully disposing of cannabis.

47 (d) As used in this subsection, the terms "manufacture,"
48 "possession," "deliver," "distribute," and "dispense" have the
49 same meanings as provided in s. 893.02.

50 (e) This subsection does not impair the license of an
51 approved dispensing organization under s. 381.986.
