Section 41. Section 100.025, Florida Statutes, is amended 6 to read:

8 100.025 Citizens residing overseas; notice of elections.-A 9 citizen of this state who is residing overseas may notify the supervisor of elections in the county where he or she is 10 11 registered of his or her overseas address; and, thereafter, the 12 supervisor shall notify such citizen at least 90 days prior to regular primary and general elections and when possible prior to 13 any special election so that such citizen may follow the 14 15 procedures for absentee voting by mail provided by law.
