under this subsection, a vessel owner must, at the time of registration, demonstrate that the vessel is equipped with an emergency position-indicating radio beacon or that the vessel owner owns a personal locator beacon. The Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles may adopt rules specifying what constitutes sufficient proof to qualify for reduced registration fees under this subsection, but such proof must contain, at a minimum, the following:

- 1. The name of the beacon owner.
- 2. The expiration date of the beacon's registration.
- 3. The unique identification number of the beacon.
- 4. For vessels equipped with an emergency positionindicating radio beacon, identification of the vessel equipped with the beacon.
- (e) For each vessel registration qualifying for reduced registration fees under this subsection, an amount equal to the difference between the full registration fee amount and the actual amount of registration fee paid for such vessel registration shall be transferred from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles and shall be distributed pursuant to s. 328.76.
- (f) Registration certificate fees provided in this subsection shall only apply to applicable vessels registered between July 1, 2016, and June 30, 2017. This subsection expires July 1, 2017.
