A bill to be entitled

An act relating to drones; amending s. 934.50, F.S.; providing for liability for damage to person or property in this state for which operation of a drone was a substantial contributing factor; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Subsections (5) and (6) of section 934.50, Florida Statutes, are renumbered as subsections (6) and (7), respectively, and a new subsection (5) is added to that section, to read:
 - 934.50 Searches and seizure using a drone.-
 - (5) LIABILITY ARISING OUT OF DRONE USE.—
- (a) Except as provided in paragraph (b), a person who suffers an injury to person or property in this state for which the operation of a drone was a substantial contributing factor is entitled to recover all damages arising from the operation of the drone from the owner and operator of the drone, jointly.
- (b) Injury to person or property in this state for which the operation of a drone was a substantial contributing factor that arises out of or is caused in substantial part by a defect in the manufacture or design of a drone may be recovered from the manufacturer, distributor, owner, and operator of the drone, jointly.
