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- (c) By July 1, 2016, the five dispensing organizations chosen for low-THC cannabis may seek authorization to produce cannabis, as authorized by this section, only after the Department of Health has received and approved additional information in a supplemental application process.
- (d) By July 1, 2016, the Department of Health shall authorize an additional 25 dispensing organizations that meet

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the requirements of s. 381.986(5)(b)2.-7. A new application process shall begin immediately upon this act becoming a law. An applicant involved in an ongoing administrative licensure challenge is not eligible to apply.

- (e) Allow a dispensing organization to make a wholesale purchase of low-THC cannabis or medical cannabis from, or a distribution of low-THC cannabis or medical cannabis to, another dispensing organization.
