The 23 course shall consist of information on the extent of labor and

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trafficking victims; patient safety and security; management of

medical records of patients who are trafficking victims; public

sex trafficking; risk factors and indicators to recognize

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and private social services available for rescue, food, clothing, and shelter referrals; hotlines for reporting human trafficking maintained by the National Human Trafficking Resource Center and the Department of Homeland Security; validated assessment tools for the identification of trafficking victims; procedures for sharing information related to human trafficking with a patient; and referral options for legal and social services as appropriate.

- (b) Each licensee or certificateholder shall submit confirmation of having completed the continuing education course, on a form provided by the board, when submitting fees for every third biennial renewal.
- (c) The board may approve additional equivalent courses that may be used to satisfy the requirements of paragraph (a). Each licensing board that requires a licensee to complete a continuing education course pursuant to this subsection may include the hour required for completion of the course in the total hours of continuing education required by law for such profession, unless the continuing education requirements for such profession consist of fewer than 30 hours biennially.
- (d) Any person holding two or more licenses subject to the provisions of this subsection shall be permitted to show proof of having taken one board-approved course on human trafficking for purposes of relicensure or recertification for additional licenses.
