Between lines 1140 and 1141, insert:

Section 24. Paragraph (d) is added to subsection (7) of section 553.80, Florida Statutes, to read:

553.80 Enforcement.-

The governing bodies of local governments may provide 10 (7) a schedule of reasonable fees, as authorized by s. 125.56(2) or 11 s. 166.222 and this section, for enforcing this part. These 12 fees, and any fines or investment earnings related to the fees, 13 shall be used solely for carrying out the local government's 14 15 responsibilities in enforcing the Florida Building Code. When 16 providing a schedule of reasonable fees, the total estimated annual revenue derived from fees, and the fines and investment 17

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18 earnings related to the fees, may not exceed the total estimated 19 annual costs of allowable activities. Any unexpended balances 20 shall be carried forward to future years for allowable 21 activities or shall be refunded at the discretion of the local government. The basis for a fee structure for allowable 22 23 activities shall relate to the level of service provided by the 24 local government and shall include consideration for refunding 25 fees due to reduced services based on services provided as prescribed by s. 553.791, but not provided by the local 26 27 government. Fees charged shall be consistently applied. 28 (d) The local enforcement agency, as defined in s. 29 553.71(5), may not require the payment of any additional fees, 30 charges, or expenses associated with: 1. Providing proof of licensure pursuant to this chapter, 31 2. Recording or filing of a license issued pursuant to 32 33 this chapter, 34 3. Providing evidence of workers' compensation coverage required by chapter 440, or 35 36 4.
