- Section 1. Paragraph (d) of subsection (2) and subsection (5) of section 316.305, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:
 316.305 Wireless communications devices; prohibition.—
 - (2) It is the intent of the Legislature to:
- (d) Authorize law enforcement officers to stop motor vehicles and issue citations as a <u>primary secondary</u> offense to persons who are texting while driving.
- (5) Enforcement of this section by state or local law enforcement agencies must be accomplished only as a secondary action when an operator of a motor vehicle has been detained for a suspected violation of another provision of this chapter, chapter 320, or chapter 322.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2016.
