6-00695-16 2016588 88 of being a recipient of the Combat Infantry Badge, Combat 89 Medical Badge, Combat Action Badge, Combat Action Ribbon, Air Force Combat Action Medal, or Distinguished Flying Cross, and 90 91 upon payment of the license tax for the vehicle as provided in 92 s. 320.08, shall be issued a license plate as provided by s. 320.06 which, in lieu of the serial numbers prescribed by s. 93 94 320.06, is stamped with the words "Veteran," "Woman Veteran," "WWII Veteran," "Navy Submariner," "National Guard," "Pearl 95 96 Harbor Survivor," "Combat-wounded veteran," "U.S. Reserve," 97 "Combat Infantry Badge," "Combat Medical Badge," "Combat Action 98 Badge," "Combat Action Ribbon," "Air Force Combat Action Medal," 99 or "Distinguished Flying Cross," as appropriate, and a likeness 100 of the related campaign medal or badge, followed by the serial 101 number of the license plate. Additionally, the Purple Heart plate may have the words "Purple Heart" stamped on the plate and 102 103 the likeness of the Purple Heart medal appearing on the plate.

104 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, beginning with fiscal year 2002-2003 and annually 105 106 thereafter, the first \$100,000 in general revenue generated from 107 the sale of license plates issued under this section shall be 108 deposited into the Grants and Donations Trust Fund, as described 109 in s. 296.38(2), to be used for the purposes established by law for that trust fund. Any additional general revenue generated 110 111 from the sale of such plates shall be deposited into the State 112 Homes for Veterans Trust Fund and used solely to construct, 113 operate, and maintain domiciliary and nursing homes for veterans, subject to the requirements of chapter 216. 114

(c) Any revenue generated from the sale of Woman Veteran license plates must be deposited into the Operations and

126	tax imposed by s. 320.08.
127	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2016.
