It is also the intent of the Legislature to eliminate duplication 28 29 of regulatory authority over agritourism as expressed in this 30 section. Except as otherwise provided for in this section, and 31 notwithstanding any other provision of law, a local government 32 may not adopt or enforce a local an ordinance, regulation, rule, or policy that prohibits, restricts, regulates, or otherwise 33 limits an agritourism activity on land classified as 34 agricultural land under s. 193.461. This subsection does not 35 36 limit the powers and duties of a local government to address 37 substantial offsite impacts of agritourism activities or an 38 emergency as provided in chapter 252.

39 Section 2. Subsection (1) of section 570.86, Florida40 Statutes, is amended to read:

41 570.86 Definitions.—As used in ss. 570.85-570.89, the 42 term:

(1)"Agritourism activity" means any agricultural related 43 44 activity consistent with a bona fide farm or ranch or in a 45 working forest which allows members of the general public, for 46 recreational, entertainment, or educational purposes, to view or 47 enjoy activities, including farming, ranching, historical, cultural, civic, ceremonial, or harvest-your-own activities and 48 attractions. An agritourism activity does not include the 49 construction of new or additional structures or facilities 50 intended primarily to house, shelter, transport, or otherwise 51 52 accommodate members of the general public.
