20	Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 570.85, Florida
21	Statutes, is amended to read:
22	570.85 Agritourism
23	(1) It is the intent of the Legislature to promote
24	agritourism as a way to support bona fide agricultural
25	production by providing a secondary stream of revenue and by
26	educating the general public about the agricultural industry. It

is also the intent of the Legislature to eliminate duplication 27 28 of regulatory authority over agritourism as expressed in this 29 section. Except as otherwise provided for in this section, and notwithstanding any other provision of law, a local government 30 may not adopt or enforce a local an ordinance, regulation, rule, 31 or policy that prohibits, restricts, regulates, or otherwise 32 33 limits an agritourism activity on land classified as agricultural land under s. 193.461. This subsection does not 34 35 limit the powers and duties of a local government to address substantial offsite impacts of agritourism activities or an 36 37 emergency as provided in chapter 252.

38 Section 2. Subsection (1) of section 570.86, Florida39 Statutes, is amended to read:

40 570.86 Definitions.—As used in ss. 570.85-570.89, the 41 term:

42 (1)"Agritourism activity" means any agricultural related 43 activity consistent with a bona fide farm, livestock operation, 44 or ranch or in a working forest which allows members of the 45 general public, for recreational, entertainment, or educational 46 purposes, to view or enjoy activities, including farming, 47 ranching, historical, cultural, civic, ceremonial, training and 48 exhibition, or harvest-your-own activities and attractions. An 49 agritourism activity does not include the construction of new or 50 additional structures or facilities intended primarily to house, shelter, transport, or otherwise accommodate members of the 51 52 general public. An activity is an agritourism activity

59	(1) In order to promote and perpetuate agriculture
60	throughout the state, farm operations are encouraged to engage
61	in agritourism. The conduct of agritourism activity on a bona
62	fide farm or on agricultural lands classified as such pursuant
63	to s. 193.461 <u>does</u> shall not limit, restrict, or divest the land
64	of that classification as long as such lands classified as
65	agricultural remain used primarily for bona fide agricultural
66	purposes.
