Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Present subsections (5) and (6) of section 934.50, Florida Statutes, are renumbered as subsections (6) and (7), respectively, and a new subsection (5) is added to that section, to read:

934.50 Searches and seizure using a drone.-

(5) LIABILITY ARISING OUT OF DRONE USE.—A drone is a dangerous instrumentality, and the owner and operator of a drone shall exercise reasonable care to prevent injuries to others. This subsection does not apply to a drone having a weight of 0.55 lbs. or less.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2016.
