(5) Each Florida College System institution and state university board of trustees is authorized to adopt policies that allow for the use of innovative pricing techniques and payment options for digital textbooks and instructional materials. Such policies may include bulk pricing arrangements that enable students to purchase integrated course materials and texts delivered digitally or through other technologies that are, or the licenses of which are, required for use within a course.
