16	and includes American Sign Language, classical languages, and

18	(c) "Gold" means the highest level of competency certified
19	by the Florida Seal of Biliteracy Program.
20	(d) "Silver" means the second-highest level of competency
21	certified by the Florida Seal of Biliteracy Program.
22	(2) The Florida Seal of Biliteracy Program is established
23	to recognize a high school graduate who has attained a high
24	level of competency in listening, speaking, reading, and writing
25	in one or more foreign languages in addition to English. The
26	Commissioner of Education shall award the Seal of Biliteracy
27	upon graduation to a high school student who meets the
28	qualifications in this section. The seal must differentiate
29	between two levels of competency, designated as Gold and Silver,
30	which must be at least as rigorous as is recommended in the
31	biliteracy seal guidelines established by national organizations
32	supporting foreign languages instruction.
33	(3) The purpose of the Florida Seal of Biliteracy Program
34	<u>is to:</u>
35	(a) Encourage students to study foreign languages.
36	(b) Certify attainment of biliteracy.
37	(c) Provide employers with a method of identifying an
38	individual with biliteracy skills who is seeking employment.
39	(d) Provide a postsecondary institution with a method of
40	recognizing an applicant with biliteracy skills who is seeking
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41	admission to the postsecondary institution.			
42	(e) Recognize and promote foreign language instruction in			
43	public schools.			
44	(f) Affirm the value of diversity, honor multiple cultures			
45	and foreign languages, and strengthen the relationships between			
46	multiple cultures in a community.			
47	(4) Beginning with the 2016-2017 school year, the Gold			
48	Seal of Biliteracy or the Silver Seal of Biliteracy must be			
49	awarded to a high school student who has earned a standard high			
50	school diploma and who:			
51	(a) Has earned four foreign language course credits in the			
52	same foreign language with a cumulative 3.0 grade point average			
53	or higher on a 4.0 scale;			
54	(b) Has achieved a qualifying score on a foreign language			
55	assessment; or			
56	(c) Has satisfied alternative requirements as determined			
57	by the State Board of Education pursuant to subsection (8).			
58	(5) The Commissioner of Education shall:
