9 standard statewide provider contract to be used with each  
10 Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program provider, with  
11 standardized attachments by provider type. The office shall  
12 publish a copy of the standard statewide provider contract on  
13 its website. The standard statewide contract shall include, at a  
14 minimum, provisions for provider probation, termination for

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15 cause, and emergency termination for those actions or inactions  
16 of a provider that pose an immediate and serious danger to the  
17 health, safety, or welfare of children. The standard statewide  
18 contract must ~~shall~~ also include appropriate due process  
19 procedures. ~~A During the pendency of an appeal of a termination,~~  
20 ~~the provider may not~~ continue to offer its services during the
