5	(5)(a) Purse supplement funds under this section are
6	intended to enhance the total purses paid per race day in
7	comparison to the purses paid by a permitholder in the previous
8	state fiscal year and to encourage live thoroughbred racing in
9	this state from May through November of each year. A
10	thoroughbred racing permitholder may not receive purse
11	supplement funds under this section unless it has an agreement
12	to this effect with the Florida Horsemen's Benevolent and
13	Protective Association, Inc., or the association representing a
14	majority of the horse owners and trainers conducting racing at
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15	the permitholder's pari-mutuel facility, for purses to be paid
16	in its upcoming licensed meet.
17	(b) In addition to accessing purse supplement funds
18	pursuant to the other provisions of this section, if any of the
19	following conditions exist on February 1 of any year, the holder
20	of a limited thoroughbred racing permit that does not possess a
21	slot machine license may apply for and receive funding for a
22	period of 3 years at 150 percent of the rate described in
23	subsection (3):
24	1. All thoroughbred racing permitholders with slot machine
25	licenses have not collectively sought pari-mutuel wagering
26	licenses for at least 160 performances and a minimum of 1,760
27	races in the next state fiscal year;
28	2. All thoroughbred racing permitholders have not
29	collectively sought pari-mutuel wagering licenses for at least
30	200 performances or a minimum of 1,760 races in the next state
31	fiscal year; or
32	3. All thoroughbred racing permitholders did not
33	collectively run at least 1,760 races in the previous state
34	fiscal year.

36	Funding under this paragraph is conditioned upon the limited
37	thoroughbred racing permitholder applying for no more
38	performances than are necessary to make up the deficiency in the
39	racing levels specified in this paragraph, with funding in the
40	following 2 years conditioned upon applying for no more than
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41	this same number of performances or the number of performances
42	necessary to make up the deficiency in the racing levels
43	specified in this paragraph at that point in time, whichever is
44	greater. Funds received under this paragraph may be used both to
45	supplement purses and to subsidize operating costs and capital
46	improvements for the pari-mutuel facility, pursuant to an
47	agreement with the association representing a majority of the
48	horse owners and trainers conducting racing at the facility.
49	(6) A thoroughbred racing permitholder receiving purse
50	supplement funds under this section shall, within 10 days after
51	receipt, remit 10 percent of those funds to the Florida
52	Thoroughbred Breeders' Association, Inc., for the payment of
53	breeders', stallion, and special racing awards, subject to the
54	fee authorized in s. 550.2625(3).
55	(7) The division may adopt rules necessary to implement
56	this section.

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
