An act relating to identification cards; amending s. 322.051, F.S.; requiring the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to issue an identification card exhibiting a special designation for a person who has a developmental disability under certain circumstances; requiring payment of an additional fee and proof of diagnosis by a licensed physician; requiring the fee to be deposited into the Agency for Persons with Disabilities Operations and Maintenance Trust Fund; authorizing issuance of a replacement identification card that includes the special designation without payment of a specified fee; requiring the department to develop rules to facilitate the issuance, requirements, and oversight of developmental disability identification cards; providing an effective date.

Section 1. Paragraph (c) is added to subsection (8) of section 322.051, Florida Statutes, to read:

322.051 Identification cards.-

24 (8)

(c) 1. Upon request by a person who has a developmental disability, or by a parent or guardian of a child or ward who has a developmental disability, the department shall issue an identification card exhibiting a capital "D" for the person, child, or ward if the person or the parent or guardian of the

child or ward submits:

a. Payment of an additional \$10 fee; and
b. Proof acceptable to the department of a diagnosis by a

licensed physician of a developmental disability as defined in
s. 393.063.

2. The department shall deposit the additional \$10 fee into
the Agency for Persons with Disabilities Operations and
Maintenance Trust Fund under s. 20.1971(2).

3. A replacement identification card that includes the
designation may be issued without payment of the fee required
under s. 322.21(1)(f).

4. The department shall develop rules to facilitate the
issuance, requirements, and oversight of developmental
disability identification cards under this section.

Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2016.
