Section 1. Subsection (18) is added to section 943.12, Florida Statutes, to read:

943.12 Powers, duties, and functions of the commission. The commission shall:

(18) On or before January 1, 2018, implement, administer, maintain, and revise an examination of basic abilities for all applicants for basic recruit training for law enforcement and corrections. The commission shall, by rule, establish procedures for the administration of the basic abilities examination. Further, the commission shall establish standards of acceptable

performance on the examination.

Section 2. Paragraph (g) of subsection (1) of section 943.17, Florida Statutes, is amended, and paragraph (h) is added to that subsection, to read:

- 943.17 Basic recruit, advanced, and career development training programs; participation; cost; evaluation.—The commission shall, by rule, design, implement, maintain, evaluate, and revise entry requirements and job-related curricula and performance standards for basic recruit, advanced, and career development training programs and courses. The rules shall include, but are not limited to, a methodology to assess relevance of the subject matter to the job, student performance, and instructor competency.
  - (1) The commission shall:
- (g) Ensure Assure that entrance into the basic recruit training program for law enforcement and correctional officers be limited to those who have passed a basic abilities skills examination and assessment instrument, based on a job task analysis in each discipline and adopted by the commission.
- (h) Set a fee for the basic abilities examination, not to exceed \$75. The fee applies to one scheduled examination attempt and is not refundable if the applicant does not appear for the examination. Fees collected pursuant to this paragraph shall be deposited in the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Trust Fund. This paragraph shall take effect upon the implementation of the revised basic abilities examination on or before January
