5 Section 1. Paragraphs (ffff) through (pppp) are added to  
6 subsection (4) of section 320.08056, Florida Statutes, to read:

7 320.08056 Specialty license plates.—

8 (4) The following license plate annual use fees shall be  
9 collected for the appropriate specialty license plates:

10 (ffff) Support Special Needs Kids license plate, \$25.

11 (gggg) America the Beautiful license plate, \$25.

12 (hhhh) Ducks Unlimited license plate, \$25.

13 (iiii) Bonefish and Tarpon Trust license plate, \$25.

14 (jjjj) Educate Engage Empower license plate, \$25.

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- 15 (kkkk) Dogs Making a Difference license plate, \$25.
- 16 (llll) National Wild Turkey Federation license plate, \$25.
- 17 (mmmm) Rotary license plate, \$25.
- 18 (nnnn) Florida Bay Forever license plate, \$25.
- 19 (oooo) Alzheimer's Disease and Caregivers license plate,
- 20 \$25.
- 21 (pppp) Safe and Free Florida license plate, \$25.

22 Section 2. Subsections (30) and (66) of section 320.08058,  
23 Florida Statutes, are amended, and subsections (84) through (94)

25 Remove lines 251-266 and insert:

26 (93) ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE AND CAREGIVERS LICENSE PLATES.-

27 (a) The department shall develop an Alzheimer's Disease  
28 and Caregivers license plate as provided in this section and s.  
29 320.08053. Alzheimer's Disease and Caregivers license plates  
30 must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The  
31 word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the  
32 words "Fight Alzheimer's, Support Caregivers" must appear at the  
33 bottom of the plate.

34 (b) The department shall retain all revenues from the sale  
35 of the plate until all startup costs for developing and issuing  
36 the plate have been recovered. Thereafter, the annual use fees  
37 shall be distributed by the department to an entity qualified as  
38 an exempt charitable organization under s. 501(c)(3) of the  
39 Internal Revenue Code which supports individuals with  
40 Alzheimer's disease or related disorders and their caregivers in

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41 this state. The entity may use up to 10 percent of the funds for  
42 administrative costs and up to 10 percent of the funds for  
43 promotion and marketing of the plate. The remainder of the funds  
44 shall be used to fund services for individuals with Alzheimer's  
45 disease or related disorders and for their caregivers in this  
46 state.

47 (94) SAFE AND FREE FLORIDA LICENSE PLATES.—

48 (a) The department shall develop a Safe and Free Florida  
49 license plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. Safe  
50 and Free Florida license plates must bear the colors and design  
51 approved by the department. The word "Florida" must appear at  
52 the top of the plate, and the words "End Human Trafficking" must  
53 appear at the bottom of the plate.

54 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plates shall  
55 be distributed to the Department of Legal Affairs, which:

56 1. May use up to 15 percent of the proceeds to promote and  
57 market the license plate.

58 2. Shall establish a program to award grants to  
59 nongovernmental organizations that shall use the awarded funds:

60 a. To provide for the material needs of sexually abused,  
61 exploited, or trafficked victims, including, but not limited to,  
62 clothing, housing, medical care, food, utilities, and  
63 transportation.

64 b. For detoxification services.

65 c. For prenatal and postnatal care and to provide services  
66 for infants awaiting placement with adoptive parents.

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67 d. To purchase or lease real estate to facilitate a safe  
68 house or a transitional care or recovery care center.

69 e. For counseling, training, awareness, and prevention  
70 programs for sexually abused, exploited, or trafficked victims.

71 f. To provide emergency legal advocacy to sexually abused  
72 or trafficked victims at a rate established by the Department of  
73 Legal Affairs.

74 (c) The Department of Legal Affairs may not distribute  
75 funds under paragraph (b) to any nongovernmental organization  
76 that charges victims for services received through this funding.  
77 An organization that receives the funds may not use the funds  
78 for administrative or capital expenditures. Each organization  
79 that receives funds must submit an annual attestation as  
80 provided in s. 320.08062 to the Department of Legal Affairs no  
81 later than December 31. The Department of Legal Affairs shall  
82 adopt and enforce rules to implement this subsection.

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
