- (94) DIABETES AWARENESS LICENSE PLATES.-
- (a) The department shall develop a Diabetes Awareness license plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The plate must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Diabetes Awareness" must appear at the bottom of the plate.

Florida Statutes, are amended, and subsections (84) through (94)

- (b) The department shall retain all annual use fees from the sale of such plates until all startup costs for developing and issuing the plates have been recovered. Thereafter, the annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall be remitted to the Department of Health for distribution as follows:
- 1. Thirty-five percent shall be retained by the Department of Health and used for diabetes-specific health services for state residents. Of this amount, up to 10 percent may be used for administrative and marketing expenses.

2. Thirty-five percent shall be distributed to the Florida
American Diabetes Association, Inc., which may use up to 5
percent of this amount for administrative expenses and the
remainder for scholarships in health fields to promote health
and wellness among minority populations and diabetes awareness
based on identified needs.

3. Thirty percent shall be distributed to LIFT Health,
Inc., a charitable, not-for-profit organization under s.
501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and sponsor of the Arthur
Green Jr. Memorial Foundation, for use as grants to promote
community engagement, education, scholarships, research, and the
public policy impact in the state and to provide medical
identification bracelets to persons with diabetes. Of this
amount, up to 5 percent may be used for administrative and
marketing expenses.
