Such objects may include 20 tangible personal property of historical or archaeological 21 value. Objects acquired under this section belong to the state, 22 and title to such objects is vested in the division. The division shall may implement a program to 23 (9) administer the discovery finds of isolated historic or 24 25 archaeological artifacts from sovereignty submerged lands. 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27	(a) An application for an annual permit and an application
28	<u>fee of \$100.</u>
29	(c) A written agreement to report all discovered and
30	removed artifacts to the division within 14 days after the
31	discovery and removal, along with a map indicating the location
32	of the discovery and photographs of the artifacts, and to allow
33	the division to inspect, analyze, and photograph any such
34	artifacts.
35	(d) A requirement that tools may not be used for the
36	excavation of any isolated artifacts, except that a trowel or
37	hand-held implement may be used to extract exposed artifacts
38	from a packed matrix in a river or lake bottom.
39	(e) A map of clearly defined areas and sites that are
40	excluded from excavation activities. The map must be provided to
41	the applicant with the issuance of a permit.
42	(f) Authorization to transfer ownership rights for
43	discovered artifacts to the permitholder.
44	(g) Penalties for violations of program requirements,
45	including, but not limited to, an administrative fine of up to
46	\$1,000 and forfeiture of the permit and ownership rights for any
47	artifacts discovered under the program state-owned river bottoms
48	whereby the division may transfer ownership of such artifacts to
49	the finder in exchange for information about the artifacts and
50	the circumstances and location of their discovery.
51	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2016.

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
