20	WaterSense product listed in paragraph (2)(a) or paragraph
21	(2)(b) with a sales price of \$500 or more. A second or
22	subsequent purchase of a specific type of Energy Star product or
23	WaterSense product with a sales price of \$500 or more is subject
24	to tax.
25	(2) As used in this section, the term:
26	(a) "Energy Star product" means a room air conditioner, air

39	and that is affixed with a WaterSense label.
