House Resolution

A resolution designating February 4, 2016, as "FAMU Day" in the State of Florida.

WHEREAS, Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University (FAMU) was founded in 1887, named a land grant institution in 1891, designated a university in 1953, and, today, has seven campuses located throughout the state serving a total of 10,229 students, and

WHEREAS, a four-year, historically black university consisting of 14 colleges and schools, FAMU offers 56 bachelor's degrees, 29 master's degrees, and 12 doctoral programs, providing immeasurable educational opportunities for young men and women from more than 70 countries, and

WHEREAS, FAMU student Jasmine A. Hall pioneered the cloning of the Flavanone 3-Hydroxylase gene from muscadine grapes, a fruit with multiple health benefits and one of the highest antioxidant levels, which will aid in the production of nutraceuticals that will benefit future consumers, and

WHEREAS, FAMU is a leading producer of African Americans with baccalaureate degrees and degrees in business management, marketing, and related fields and a leading producer of African-American pharmacists in the nation, and

WHEREAS, nearly one-third of FAMU's student body is pursuing degrees in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) or health-related disciplines, and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Agriculture has awarded FAMU more than \$1.3 million in grants to support the university's research, teaching, and extension activities in the fields of agriculture, the environment, and public health, and

WHEREAS, The College Database 2013 recognized FAMU as the second most affordable public institution for providing high-quality education in the state, the Social Mobility Index 2014 classified FAMU as the third highest ranked institution for facilitating economic opportunity for underserved students in the nation, U.S. News & World Report recognized FAMU as one of its "2015 Best Colleges," and Best-Pharmacy-Schools.com currently ranks FAMU's College of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences as the third highest ranked pharmacy school in the state, and

WHEREAS, FAMU's women's cross country team won its fourth consecutive Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference Cross Country Championship in 2015, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Florida:

That February 4, 2016, is designated as "FAMU Day" in the State of Florida in recognition of Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University's contributions as an outstanding institution of higher education.
