15	of an antidiabetic medication to treat type 1 diabetes mellitus.
16	(2) If the Governor issues, with the exception of those
17	areas or counties included in an emergency order or proclamation
18	of a state of emergency declared by the Governor , in which the
19	executive order may authorize the pharmacist <u>may</u> to dispense up
20	to a 30-day supply in the areas or counties affected by the
21	order or proclamation, provided providing that:
22	<u>(a)</u> The prescription is not for a medicinal drug listed
23	in Schedule II appearing in chapter 893.
24	(b) (2) The medication is essential to the maintenance of
25	life or to the continuation of therapy in a chronic condition.
26	(c)(3) In the pharmacist's professional judgment, the
27	interruption of therapy might reasonably produce undesirable
28	health consequences or may cause physical or mental discomfort.
29	(d)(4) The dispensing pharmacist creates a written order
30	containing all of the prescription information required by this
31	chapter and chapters 499 and 893 and signs that order.
32	(e)(5) The dispensing pharmacist notifies the prescriber
33	of the emergency dispensing within a reasonable time after such
34	dispensing.
