A bill to be entitled

An act relating to unfair insurance trade practices; amending s. 626.9541, F.S.; revising provisions to permit a licensed insurer or its agent to give promotional or advertising items under a certain value; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (m) of subsection (1) of section 626.9541, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

626.9541 Unfair methods of competition and unfair or deceptive acts or practices defined.—

- (1) UNFAIR METHODS OF COMPETITION AND UNFAIR OR DECEPTIVE ACTS.—The following are defined as unfair methods of competition and unfair or deceptive acts or practices:
- (m) <u>Promotional items</u> <u>Advertising gifts</u> permitted.—No provision of paragraph (f), paragraph (g), or paragraph (h) shall be deemed to prohibit a licensed insurer or its agent from giving <u>prizes</u>, goods, wares, gift cards, gift certificates, event tickets, merchandise, and other items valued at \$100 or <u>less</u> to insureds, prospective insureds, and others, for the purpose of <u>conducting a promotional or advertising program</u>. An insurer or its agent may not give such promotional items that exceed \$100 in total value within one calendar year to an <u>individual</u> advertising, any article of merchandise having a value of not more than \$25.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2017.
