27	(b) Successful completion of coursework in foundations of
28	bilingualism, biliteracy, and bilingual education.
29	(c) Successful completion of coursework in methods,

32	(d) Successful completion of clinical experience in a
33	bilingual educational setting.
34	(e) Demonstration of bilingual and biliterate proficiency.
35	(2) Courses used to meet the bilingual education
36	requirements of this section must be taught by a faculty member
37	with a terminal degree in Bilingual Education, Applied
38	Linguistics, World Language, Teaching English to Speakers of
