A bill to be entitled

An act relating to school district instructional and administrative personnel; creating s. 1012.08, F.S.; providing that certain school district employees have a cause of action under the Whistle-blower's Act for the disclosure of certain information; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 1012.08, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

instructional and administrative personnel.—An employee of a school district whose professional responsibilities are defined in s. 1012.01(2) and (3) who is discharged, demoted, suspended, threatened, harassed, or in any other manner discriminated against in the terms and conditions of employment by his or her employer because the employee discloses the improper use of school district practices or procedures deemed to be school—related fraud, a suspected violation of law or rule, the dishonest reporting or misrepresentation of the employee's services, or an activity or incident that has had a negative effect on the education of students or a school's performance shall have a cause of action under s. 112.3187.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2017.
