3 **Amendment to Amendment (171781)**

4 Remove lines 592-624 of the amendment and insert:

5 1. The technical and technological ability to cultivate  
6 and produce low-THC cannabis and marijuana.

7 2. The ability to secure the premises, resources, and  
8 personnel necessary to operate as a medical marijuana treatment  
9 center.

10 3. The ability to maintain accountability of all raw  
11 materials, finished products, and any byproducts to prevent  
12 diversion or unlawful access to or possession of these  
13 substances.

14       4. An infrastructure reasonably located to dispense  
15 marijuana to registered qualified patients statewide or  
16 regionally as determined by the department.

17       5. The financial ability to maintain operations for the  
18 duration of the 2-year approval cycle, including the provision  
19 of certified financial statements to the department. Upon  
20 approval, the applicant must post a \$5 million performance bond.  
21 However, a medical marijuana treatment center serving at least  
22 1,000 qualified patients is only required to maintain a \$2  
23 million performance bond.

24       6. That all owners, officers, board members, and managers  
25 have passed a background screening pursuant to subsection (9).

26       7. The employment of a medical director to supervise the
