- (3) PREEMPTION OF REGULATION TO THE STATE.—
 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, this section expressly
 preempts the regulation of businesses, professions, and
 occupations to the state and supersedes any local government
 regulation of businesses, professions, or occupations with the
 exception of the following:
- (a) A regulation adopted prior to January 1, 2017, without general law authority. Any such regulation expires on January 1, 2020.
 - (b) A regulation expressly authorized by general law.
- (4) EXISTING REGULATION LIMIT.-A local government with a local regulation concerning a business, profession, or occupation that is retained pursuant to paragraph (3)(a) may not impose additional regulations on that business, profession, or occupation or modify such regulation except to repeal or reduce the regulation.
- (5) REGULATIONS NOT AUTHORIZED.—Any local regulation of businesses, professions, or occupations that is not authorized under this section or expressly authorized by general law does not apply and may not be enforced.
