> Section 2. Subsection (1) of section 744.367, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

744.367 Duty to file annual guardianship report.-

(1) Unless the court requires filing on a calendar-year basis, each guardian of the person shall file with the court an annual guardianship plan within 90 days after at least 60 days,



but no more than 90 days, before the last day of the anniversary month that the letters of quardianship were signed, and the plan must cover the coming fiscal year, ending on the last day in such anniversary month. If the court requires calendar-year filing, the guardianship plan for the forthcoming calendar year must be filed on or before April 1 of each year. The latest annual guardianship plan approved by the court will remain in effect until the court approves a subsequent plan-after September 1 but no later than December 1 of the current year.
