19-01509-17 20171734 88 proof of membership in the Pearl Harbor Survivors Association or 89 proof of active military duty in Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941, proof of being a Purple Heart medal recipient, proof of 90 active or retired membership in any branch of the United States 91 92 Armed Forces Reserve, or proof of membership in the Combat Infantrymen's Association, Inc., proof of being a recipient of 93 94 the Combat Infantry Badge, Combat Medical Badge, Combat Action Badge, Combat Action Ribbon, Air Force Combat Action Medal, or 95 Distinguished Flying Cross, and upon payment of the license tax 96 97 for the vehicle as provided in s. 320.08, shall be issued a 98 license plate as provided by s. 320.06 which, in lieu of the 99 serial numbers prescribed by s. 320.06, is stamped with the words "Veteran," "Woman Veteran," "WWII Veteran," "Navy 100 Submariner, " "National Guard, " "Pearl Harbor Survivor, " "Combat-101 wounded veteran, " "U.S. Reserve," "Combat Infantry Badge," 102 "Combat Medical Badge," "Combat Action Badge," "Combat Action 103 Ribbon, " "Air Force Combat Action Medal," or "Distinguished 104 105 Flying Cross," as appropriate, and a likeness of the related 106 campaign medal or badge, followed by the serial number of the 107 license plate. Additionally, the Purple Heart plate may have the 108 words "Purple Heart" stamped on the plate and the likeness of 109 the Purple Heart medal appearing on the plate.

(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, beginning with fiscal year 2002-2003 and annually thereafter, the first \$100,000 in general revenue generated from the sale of license plates issued under this section shall be deposited into the Grants and Donations Trust Fund, as described in s. 296.38(2), to be used for the purposes established by law for that trust fund. Any additional general revenue generated
